FAILURE TO COMPLETE ALL REQUIREMENTS MAY RESULT IN LOAD REFUSAL

The Southern Idaho Solid Waste District accepts large animal carcasses and offal. Loads of animal carcasses and offal must follow these guidelines:

- Carcasses and offal may only be accepted during a one-hour time period each day. Please contact your local transfer station for the times they will be accepting this waste.
- Prior notice and/or an appointment is required before carcasses and/or offal can be disposed of at the transfer stations. The transfer stations may refuse waste brought in without prior notice.
- No more than 2 large animal carcasses or 5 cubic yards of offal may be deposited at the transfer stations in any one day, from any one source. Larger volumes of carcasses/offal must be taken directly to the Milner Butte Landfill. Prior notice is required before carcasses/offal can be accepted.
- The fee for disposal of offal at any transfer station not equipped with scales will be \$22/cubic yard (based on an average weight to volume ratio of 1,100 lb/cubic yard).
- The fee for disposal of large animal carcasses at any transfer station not equipped with scales will be \$15 per carcass.
- Disposal fees for large animal carcasses/offal at transfer stations equipped with scales will be equal to the fee for municipal solid waste. Please contact the appropriate transfer station for more information.
- The fee for disposal of carcasses and/or offal at Milner Butte Landfill will remain at \$16/ton.
