FAILURE TO COMPLETE ALL REQUIREMENTS MAY RESULT IN LOAD REFUSAL

The Southern Idaho Solid Waste District (SISW) accepts household hazardous waste (HHW) at several sites. **Transfer station and scale house attendants must inspect each load entering the facility for HHW.** Acceptance is dependent on the review of source and generation information. SISW has the right to refuse loads and/or require additional testing. Loads are also subject to random load inspections.

1) Acceptable Types of HHW:

Used motor oil – 5 gallons per visit or 25 gallons per month. Acceptable in unmarked containers and must be transferred without spilling.

Antifreeze - 5 gallons per visit or 25 gallons per month. Acceptable in unmarked containers and must be transferred without spilling.

Flammable and Combustible Liquids - 5 gallons per visit or 25 gallons per month. It must be in original sealed container.

Corrosives – Must be less than 2 gallons to accept at transfer station, anything above that needs to be directed to the Environmental Manager.

Pesticide, Herbicide, or Fertilizer- 5 gallons per visit or 25 gallons per month. It must be in original sealed container.

Mercury – Thermometers, thermostats, and elemental mercury (small containers) are accepted in our HHW program. (Please see SISW Mercury Policy)

*We do not limit the HHW diversion program to these items. If it is a peculiar waste that has a potential hazard we may need pull an MSDS and dispose of it properly. Please direct these customers to the Environmental Manager at Milner Butte Landfill.
